Trauma-Informed Care Initiative (TIC IT)

"The procurement exemption we had in place to allow TIC IT funds to reimburse the cost of Seeking Safety groups in our Day Treatment and IOH programs expires on April 30th. While we work to find a solution to this issue please note that we will not be able to pay claims for any Seeking Safety groups that occur on May 1 and beyond, using the TIC IT codes found in your Day Treatment or IOH contracts.

Some of the consumers who are currently attending the TIC IT funded Seeking Safety groups may be eligible to receive similar services through the Day Treatment program or IOH. If you believe they meet eligibility for admittance to Day Treatment or IOH you or the individual's Case Manager may submit a referral for authorization to AMHD UM.

We realize this may result in a break in service for most of the individuals currently receiving Seeking Safety and we appreciate your patience and assistance in helping our consumers make this difficult transition. We will be working to bring a solution forward as quickly as possible. Thank you for your understanding."
