

**REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS
ON DRAFT AIR PERMIT
REGULATING THE EMISSIONS OF AIR POLLUTANTS**

(Docket No. 13-CA-PA-24)

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), Chapter 342B-13 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), Chapter 11-60.1, the Department of Health, State of Hawaii (DOH), is requesting public comments on the following **DRAFT PERMIT** presently under review for:

Covered/Temporary Covered Source Permit (CSP) No. 0332-01-C/CT

Application for Renewal and Significant Modification No. 0332-08

O. Thronas Inc., dba Kauai Aggregates

700 TPH Stone Quarrying and Processing Plant

Located at: 1. Halewili Road, Eleele, Kauai

UTM: Zone 4, 440,500 m E, 2,422,250 m N (NAD 83)

2. Various Temporary Sites, State of Hawaii (Various Equipment)

The **DRAFT PERMIT** is described as follows:

Covered/Temporary Covered Source Permit No. 0332-01-C/CT will grant conditional approval for the continued operation of a 700 TPH stone quarrying and processing plant. The proposed modification includes the removal and addition of crushers and screens. The stone quarrying and processing plant is equipped with water sprays to control particulate matter emissions. The stone quarrying and processing plant is subject to 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 60, Subpart OOO, Standards of Performance for Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants. This permit, if issued, will supersede CSP No. 0332-01-C/CT, issued on July 15, 2011, in its entirety.

The proposed modification results in the following net emissions change:

The **ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD**, consisting of the **APPLICATION** and non-confidential supporting material from the applicant, the permit review summary, and the **DRAFT PERMIT**, is available for public inspection during regular office hours, Monday through Friday, 7:45 a.m. to 4:15 p.m., at the following locations:

All comments on the draft permit and any request for a public hearing must be in writing, addressed to the Clean Air Branch at the above address on Oahu and must be postmarked or received by **September 5, 2013**.

Any person may request a public hearing by submitting a written request that explains the party's interest and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. At the sole discretion of the Director of Health, DOH may hold a public hearing if a hearing would aid in DOH's decision. If a public hearing is warranted, a public notice for the hearing will be published at least thirty days in advance of the hearing.

Interested persons may obtain copies of the administrative record or parts thereof at a copying cost of five cents per page. Please send written requests to the Oahu office of the Clean Air Branch listed above or call Mr. Mark Saewong at the Clean Air Branch in Honolulu at (808) 586-4200. Electronic copies of the draft permit and permit review may be found online at <http://health.hawaii.gov/cab/public-notices/>.

Comments on the draft permit should address, but need not be limited to, the permit conditions and the facility's compliance with federal and state air pollution laws, including: (1) the National and State Ambient Air Quality Standards; and (2) HRS, Chapter 342B and HAR, Chapter 11-60.1.

DOH will make a final decision on the permit after considering all comments and will send notice of the final decision to each person who has submitted comments or requested such notice.
