Established new rules to restrict open burning on all islands Greenhouse Gas rules – to address climate change Goal: get emissions below 1990 levels by 2020 Volcanic emissions (track NAAQS) Monitor at 6 locations (1 hr and 24 hr exceedences) Ambient levels of air-borne particulates - low HI: Below EPA national standard (HI 4.7 PM2.5^{*}) Ambient levels of Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) in Honolulu – low Ambient levels of Carbon Monoxide (CO) in Honolulu decreasing 1.4ppm


