Topic Description

Water Quality Testing and Supply Management: This course is designed to familiarize the individuals in attendance with a comprehensive review of testing and laboratory procedures along with source protection, water quality concerns, and supply/demand management techniques.

Overview of Water Storage Facilities O&M and BMPs: This course is designed to familiarize the individuals in attendance with a comprehensive review of water storage requirements, types of facilities, configuration, equipment, safety concerns and preventive maintenance requirements.
