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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT July 2013

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** No meeting in June. Next meeting is scheduled for July 8, 2013. Members will receive an update on the Kauai Community Health Needs Assessment from Dr. Dileep G. Bal, Kauai District Health Officer.
- Honolulu** Members met on June 6, 2013. Dr. Cullen Hayashida of the Kupuna Education Center at the Kapiolani Community College spoke about aging and long-term-care (LTC) tactical planning for Hawaii. He provided data on Hawaii's LTC bed capacity in contrast to Hawaii's growing 65+ population, the high costs for various acute and LTC services, LTC funding sources, and projections on what the regional nursing home bed needs will be based on estimates of the growing 85+ population. He reviewed what factors might plague the LTC system such as no indicator dashboard or no clear direction. He reviewed what factors should be considered to achieve an LTC system that meets the demand for LTC services with limited resources. Finally, Dr. Hayashida discussed current initiatives that are working towards the goal of "Active Life Expectancy." These include federal and state policy directions for LTC program development, aging-in-place strategy, managed care, increasing home and community-based capacity, workforce strategies, and the active aging initiative.
- West Oahu** Members met on June 5, 2013, and heard from Michiyo Tomioka who offered a presentation entitled "Organizational Change in the Aging Network to Promote Evidence-Based Programs". Members also learned from Maria Pacheco, Chair, Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council about the "School-Based Clinic at Kahuku High School".
- Windward Oahu** No meeting in June.
- Tri-Isle** Members met on June 14, 2013, and heard guest speakers Naomi Sugihara, Toni Torres, and Sam Valeriano who provided a presentation on "Kauai CHNA and Community Health Improvement -- Making A Case for Community Engagement". The presenters offered information on how they conducted an inclusive community planning process on improving community health.

Hawaii No meeting in June. Members are scheduled to meet on July 2, 2013, to hear from Mark A. Fridovich, Ph.D., M.P.A., Chief, Adult Mental Health Division, Hawaii Department of Health who will present information on the "Special Action Team (SAT), Legislative Session, and Outlook for 2013".
