Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** Members are scheduled to meet with Dr. Dileep G. Bal, District Health Officer, Kauai District Health Office, Hawaii Department on Health on August 22, 2012. Dr. Bal will brief members on the major forces and trends impacting health and the healthcare on Kauai island.
- Honolulu** Colonel (Retired) Suzie Martin, the Regional Telehealth Director of the Pacific Regional Medical Command (PRMC) provided an overview of the services, locations, functions and scope of the PRMC's Telehealth and telemedicine operations. Locations for services include Hawaii, American Samoa, Guam, Okinawa, South Korea, and Japan. Services include Tele-Behavioral Health, Child and Adolescent Telehealth Services, Traumatic Brain Injury/Concussion Clinic, and Tele-Critical Care Unit. She also mentioned the other types of programs under development as well as the challenges of the system. The next scheduled meeting is August 2, 2012.
