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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT March 2011

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Subarea health planning council members in Kauai, Maui, and Hawaii counties have not met due to budgetary concerns.

Kauai No meeting in February.

Honolulu At the February 3, 2011 meeting, Lloyd Lim, Insurance Division, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, briefly provided an update and distributed a handout on the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). Hawaii's Prepaid Healthcare Act should continue to apply at least to 2014. An opinion from the State Attorney General is being sought regarding how PPACA will affect Hawaii's Prepaid Healthcare Act.

Mary Rydell, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, provided an overview on how the PPACA and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 or HCERA will affect the administration of the Medicare program. It should be noted that PPACA and HCERA are more commonly referred to as the Affordable Care Act. Discussion included updates on the original Medicare (e.g. Medicare Claims Limit, Preventive Services), Medicare Advantage (Part C), Medicare Prescription Drug Coverage (e.g. Income-related premiums, coverage gap), the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act (HITECH), the Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Program, and the Nursing Home Five-Star Quality Rating System.
