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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT July 2014

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council did not meet in June. Members are scheduled to meet on July 14 and hear guest presenter: Mr. Lyle Takaba, Co-Chair, *Kauai Community Health Improvement Planning Process: Workgroup on Community Design and Planning*. Mr. Tabata will provide an update of the workgroup and highlight some of the proposed strategies, goals, and next steps.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council met on June 5, 2014. Members continued their discussion on the early detection and diagnosis of the Alzheimer's disease public awareness project. The next meeting is July 3, 2014.

Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council met on June 5, 2014, and heard a presentation on "Substance Abuse Services" given by Chris Yamamoto, Planner; and Dixie Thompson, Chief of Prevention Branch; Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division, Hawaii Department of Health.
- Tri-Isle** Members met on June 13, and heard a presentation on "Housing and Related Support Services" offered by Roy K. Katsuda, Executive Director, Hale Mahaolu (HM); Kathryn Louis, Director of Personal Care/Kupuna Care Program, HM; and Rhonda M. Lincoln, Manager of Kitchen and Director of Meals Program, HM. Mr. Katsuda briefed members on Hale Mahaolu, a private, nonprofit housing corporation. He provided a historical review of HM's principles, vision and mission; present day housing projects and services; and future plans. HM, "home of pleasant living", strives to offer a better living environment for residents and to help residents remain independent in their own home for as long as possible. Ms. Louis reported on HM's home and community based services, including Kupuna Care In-Home Care Services, HM Personal Care Program, and Medicaid Waiver Personal Care. Ms. Lincoln briefed members on HM's kitchen and meals program.
