## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT July 2015

### Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) members met on June 23, 2015. Members reviewed and made revisions to the draft of the updated *Assets Mapping: Kauai Island*. The next meeting is August 27, 2015.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) members met on June 4, 2015. Mr. Colin Kippen, the State Homeless Coordinator, gave a brief overview of the unofficial 2015 Homeless Point-in-Time Count report that was released in the news. His discussion included how housing is health care and how homelessness is a major cause of poor health and drives up health care costs. The next meeting is July 2, 2015.

Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) members and Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) members did not meet in June.
