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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT June 2015

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) members met on May 18, 2015. Despite lack of quorum, members elected to hear the presentation scheduled for the meeting. Mr. Lee Steinmetz, of the Kauai County Planning Department, provided a review of the Kauai County's TIGER grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation. The application focused on Lihue Town Core mobility and revitalization. Mr. Steinmetz reviewed the project goals, components already in progress by the County and cost estimates. The next meeting will be on June 23, 2015.

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council members met on May 7, 2015. Members concluded the Early Detection and Diagnosis of Alzheimer's Project by deciding to not continue the public awareness component of the initiative. With regards to the health professional training component, the unofficial attendance counts indicate that over 480 health professionals statewide participated in the trainings. Almost half of the participants were physicians, one-third was nurses, and the remaining included psychologists, social workers, and occupational therapists. When possible, professional educational credits were awarded for either the physicians or nurses. The trainings were successful as approximately 99% of those who completed evaluations rated the trainings excellent, very good, or good. A special Mahalo is extended to Dr. Kore Liow, Dr. Kamal Masaki, and the Alzheimer's Association—Aloha Chapter for working in partnership with the HONSAC by conducting these trainings. The next meeting will be June 4, 2015.
