Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not meet in October. The next meeting will be November 12, 2015.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on October 1, 2015. Members will research and explore how to support public awareness efforts to prevent elder abuse. The next meeting will be November 5, 2015.

- Windward Oahu**
The Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not meet in October.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) met on October 16, 2015 to learn about the intergenerational (IG) program at the Nisei Veterans Memorial Center. Part of the Nisei Veterans Memorial Center's vision was to build an IG program that would include an adult day care facility and a preschool open to all in the community. IG programs are programs that bridge the generational gap by offering younger and older generations the opportunity to interact. To fulfill this vision, the Maui Adult Day Care Center (MADCC) works with the Kansha Preschool to provide opportunities for the Kupuna to interact with the preschool children. The Kupuna at MADCC suffer from high, moderate, or low levels of dementia or are adults who may be isolated and do not have opportunities for social interaction. The interaction with youth may bring back wonderful memories of the Kupuna's own children or working with children and the opportunity also helps the children to become comfortable with those aging but yet able-bodied or have disabilities.
