## Request for Legal Signage for Tobacco and Electronic Smoking Devices Vendors

Dear Merchant,

This is to inform you that on June 27, 2013, Act 227 was signed into law. It is now illegal to sell tobacco products and electronic smoking devices to persons under 18. Also, all vendors must post new legal signage at or near the point of sales where tobacco products or electronic smoking devices are sold.

The Department of Health is providing legal tobacco signs. Please replace any outdated red signs with the official tobacco signage. For additional signs, please contact us with your request.

Thank you for your help in preventing the sales of tobacco and electronic smoking devices to minors and for your concern about the health of our keiki.
