ORDER PERMITTING CRAIG D. JENSEN, ESQ. TO ASSOCIATE HIMSELF WITH A MEMBER OF THE HAWAI'I BAR IN THE PRESENTATION OF THIS CONTESTED-CASE PROCEEDING ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY

A status conference was held on December 13, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. Wade H. Hargrove III, Deputy Attorney General, appeared on behalf of Complainant Department of Health, State of Hawai'i ("DOH"). David FitzPatrick, Esq., and Craig D. Jensen, Esq., appeared on behalf of Respondent United States Department of the Navy ("Navy").

At the status conference, Mr. Jensen orally moved to be permitted to represent the Navy in this proceeding pursuant to HAR § 11-1-32(b), by associating himself with a member of the Hawai'i bar, Mr. David FitzPatrick, Esq. (HI Bar #6803). Mr. Jensen stated that he is a member of the bar of the State of Washington in good standing. Mr. Jensen agreed to be bound by the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct for the

duration of this proceeding. Mr. Jensen further confirmed at a status conference held

on December 14, 2021, that he is not a resident of or regularly employed in the State of

Hawai'i.

Therefore, based upon the representations of counsel, and in the Hearings

Officer's discretion, it is ordered that Mr. Craig D. Jensen, Esq. shall be permitted to

associate himself with Mr. David FitzPatrick in the presentation of this contested-case

hearing on behalf of the Navy pursuant to HAR § 11-1-32(b). This order shall apply

nunc pro tunc to December 13, 2021.
