SUBJECT: Addendum - Authorized Evacuation of Personnel, Dependents, and Employees Impacted by Water Contamination

2. On 2 December 2021, I authorized evacuation of eligible persons impacted by water contamination. Further analysis indicates there were other military communities impacted by water contamination. This memorandum adds these additional military communities, impacted by water contamination, to the original evacuation authorization. Eligible persons, as defined in the 9 December 2021 evacuation authorization memorandum, who reside in the following military communities, are authorized to evacuate IAW reference h: Camp Smith, Ford Island, Halawa, Hale Alii, Hale Moku, Hokulani, Hospital Point, Maloelap, Manana, McGrew Point, Pearl City Peninsula, Makalapa, and Onizuka Village.
