I've gotten the following baseline thresholds from EV:

1

- 1. Small indefinite chronic release of 2,300 gallons per tank per year (or 6.3 gallons per tank per day).
- 2. Large sudden release of 120,000 gallons.

My understanding is that these thresholds would get us to an "unsafe drinking water" condition at our Red Hill shaft.

With the data/analysis that you have now, is there anything you can provide that we could use in our preparation for discussions with EPA/DOH (week of August 13, but we're preparing the data over the next two weeks)? Any data used would be preliminary and subject to your final report.
