20 NOVEMBER 2021 INCIDENTS AT RED HILL BULK FUEL STORAGE  
FACILITY

1. In accordance with references (a) and (b), the following is added to paragraph 3 of reference (c): "In addition to your assigned tasking herein, you are also directed to investigate whether the events of 6 May 2021, 20 November 2021, or any other similar event at Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (Red Hill) contributed to or caused the contamination of the Navy water system in and around Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam and its surrounding areas."
2. Paragraph 7 of reference (c) is amended to read as follows: "You are to complete this report and return it to me by close of business on 14 January 2022."
3. Reference (c) remains in effect as amended in paragraphs 1 and 2 above.
4. Our paramount obligation is to protect the health and welfare of service members, civilians, and their families. We must, therefore, ensure they have access to safe water. Your investigation will directly assist our efforts to identify the source of any water contamination, protect our community, and safeguard the environment.
