Wellness Recovery Action Plan (WRAP) is a personalized best practice tool taught in an in-person group setting by a team of co-facilitators. Any individual interested in learning how to improve their resiliency and overall effectiveness to proactively address stressors, trauma, and self-care, while also creating an understanding and empathy for others.

The Copeland Center defines WRAP as, "a personalized wellness and recovery system born out of and rooted in the principle of self-determination. WRAP is a wellness and recovery approach to help individuals to: 1) decrease and prevent intrusive or troubling feelings and behaviors; 2) increase personal empowerment; 3) improve quality of life; and 4) achieve life goals and dreams. Living with a WRAP means individuals can monitor their uncomfortable and distressing feelings and behaviors and, through planned responses, can reduce, modify, or eliminate those feelings. A WRAP also includes plans for responses from others when individuals cannot make decisions, take care of themselves, or keep themselves safe."

To join a Hawaii WRAP group, please contact one of the following individuals. Groups are co-facilitated and are scheduled statewide, in-person, and at various locations and times across the state. Currently, there are no fees to attend WRAP groups. Upon completion, participants earn a certificate of completion and will have a developed a personalized WRAP.
