Aloha, Hawaii CARES 988 is a free service jointly administered by the Hawaii State Department of Health's (DOH), Adult Mental Health Division (AMHD), Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD), and Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division (ADAD).

Included with this letter are recently printed Hawaii CARES 988 materials. Over the next several months, these materials will be shared through our behavioral health provider network and at community health education events.

#### Background

Hawaii residents have had access to this free statewide telephonic mental health crisis response call center since 2002. In 2019, Hawaii CARES became a coordinated resource entry system (CARES) by expanding services to include support for substance use disorder (SUD) treatment. In July 2022, when the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline transitioned to a 3-digit call number, 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline calls and chat messages from our Hawaii 808 area code were connected to the Hawaii CARES 988 call center.

#### Services

## Toll free 1-800-753-6870 or Dial 988 from a Hawaii 808 area code

- 24 hours a day, 7 day a week call center operations with locally based crisis screeners.
- Confidential telephonic supportive counseling and screening for urgent or emergent mental or emotional health needs, including callers who are thinking about suicide.
- Linkage to SUD treatment services and community-based crisis intervention.
- Recommendations for behavioral health assessments and services.



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# **Overview and Purpose**

#### Aloha!

The Hawai'i State Department of Health, Adult Mental Health Division (AMHD) is proud to partner with state operated (SO) Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) and contracted purchase-of-service (POS) providers that offer mental health and co-occurring disorder treatment, services and supports to adults who live with mental illness when and where these essential services are needed.

Funding for AMHD services is provided through state general funds and federal grant funds. Providers and are routinely monitored for compliance with contractual agreements.

The original purpose of this directory continues to be our driving purpose:

To provide a tool for collaboration amongst providers that empowers their staff to communicate efficiently and directly with other provider staff in order to address coordination responsibilities that providers are dually responsible for.

Coordination responsibilities may differ depending on the situation; however, general strategies for intended use of this directory include:

- ➤ If a case management provider is coordinating a housing move from/to a housing provider site, the case manager staff may refer to this list and decide call, email or fax the housing provider (and importantly, vice versa).
- > If AMHD staff need to contact a provider to follow up on an administrative concern, this list helps to identify the appropriate provider staff.

  - o Individuals with mental illness and substance use disorders (co-occurring).
- Meeting, consulting and receiving feedback from community members including public input and inviting resource speakers to address relevant topics.
- Advising the Governor, through the DOH, about the:
  - o Provision of statewide mental health services, treatment and supports,
  - Allocation of mental health resources, and
  - Identification of needs affecting two or more service areas (via counties-based Service Area Boards on Mental Health and Substance Abuse).
- Reviewing and commenting on the Statewide Comprehensive Integrated Service Plan (SCISP), also referred to as the Community Mental Health Block Grant (CMHBG).


