At the Adult Mental Health Division (AMHD), we believe love can take many forms that support mental healing and wellness.

Community love grows in AMHD **Clubhouses**, where members are part of a team—sharing daily work, building skills, and contributing in meaningful ways. This sense of responsibility and mutual help can restore hope, purpose, and acceptance.

Peer love comes through AMHD's **Hawaii Certified Peer Specialists** program. Mental Health Peer Specialists (MHPS) are people who have lived through mental health challenges and now support others—without labels or clinical language—by honoring personal identity, choice, and strengths.

If romantic love feels distant right now, know this: connection, care, and fulfillment are still within reach. Exploring AMHD services can be a powerful step toward wellness, belonging, and a life grounded in many forms of love.
