

### WHAT IS CAMHD?

The Child & Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD) is part of the Hawai'i Department of Health and provides mental health services free of charge for eligible children and youth who have severe emotional and/or behavioral challenges.

### WHAT DOES THE CAMHD EDL DO?

**The EDL connects emergency departments and CAMHD team members to facilitate mental health crisis care.**

For non-CAMHD youth, the EDL provides information on how to apply for CAMHD services, available crisis resources and community supports.
