Frequently Asked Questions

What services does the CAMHD provide?

- The CAMHD Care Coordinators provide intensive case management services as part of a clinical team with CAMHD psychologists and psychiatrists.
- The CAMHD contracts with private providers. Client care is co-managed between the treatment provider and CAMHD.
- A wide array of home and community-based mental health treatment services are offered based on the youth's specific needs. The CAMHD promotes the use of effective therapeutic approaches through research at all levels of care:
 - Crisis Services
 - Family Therapy
 - Home-Based Therapy
 - Hospital-Based Services
 - Residential Treatment Programs
 - Transitional Family Home Programs

Who is eligible to receive services from the CAMHD?

- **A youth who is:**
 - 3-20 years old;
 - Has significant impairment in functioning at home, at school, and/or, in the community; and
 - Has a qualifying mental health diagnosis (substance use or developmental disability without another mental health diagnosis does not qualify).
