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	<p>(RFP) Process utilized by the Hawaii Community Foundation (HCF) grantmaking programs which includes those grants funded by the Tobacco Prevention and Control Trust Fund.</p> <p>Since 2000, the DOH has contracted HCF to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manage and monitor investment performance of the Trust Fund. • Administer community programs – cessation, youth prevention and tobacco control vendors such as the Hawaii Tobacco Quitline. <p>HCF has a standard decision- making process approved by their Board of Governors.</p> <p>RFP Flowchart Process shared.</p>		<p>RFP Flowchart Handout provided in meeting packet.</p> <p>Members expressed appreciation for flowchart clarity as it highlights the RFP process very transparently.</p>
<p>Review of Tobacco Trust Fund Budget for 2022</p>	<p>Matsuda shared the proposed 2022 Tobacco Prevention & Control Trust Fund Budget.</p> <p>Overview of major programs and providers included in the budget shared.</p>		<p>Hirokawa asked in terms of surveillance if there is any need by the DOH for increased capacity as it relates to the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) and Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). Is DOH able to track trends over time? It's very important to be able to track that to understand what's going on.</p> <p>Irvin responded that due to reduced federal funding and reduced support from CDC, DOH is only conducting YRBS and not Youth Tobacco Survey (YTS) this year. CDC no longer provides data cleansing and weighting, and technical support for the YTS.</p> <p>Irvin requested time for DOH to come back to Advisory Board with a response to include impact of loss of YTS data and what cost would be if Advisory Board is to</p>

Expressed concerned regarding methodological issues that may prevent continuous analysis of data. Interested in knowing what questions are being maintained and what questions will be left out.</p> <p>Chair asked for confirmation whether at the end of grant cycles in 2022 & 2023 new grants will reflect most recent strategic plan with subgroup representation. Matsuda confirmed that yes, this is correct and the current strategic plan will be reflected in any future RFPs being issued.</p> <p>Tobacco Trust Fund Budget for 2022 was adopted unanimously.</p>
