

COVID-19 CLOSE CONTACT NOTIFICATION FOR SCHOOLS

FOR SCHOOLS IMPLEMENTING OPTIONAL INDOOR MASKING POLICIES

You have been identified as a close contact to a person with COVID-19 infection at our school. If you are up to date on COVID-19 vaccination as defined by [Hawai'i State Department of Health K-12 Summary School Guidance](#), you do not have to quarantine and can remain in school.

If you are ***not*** up to date on COVID-19 vaccination per HDOH guidance, you ***must*** remain at home in quarantine for 5 days after your last contact with the person with COVID-19 and you must wear a well-fitting mask for an additional 5 days after your quarantine has ended.

You can return to school on _____, if ***all*** conditions are met:

1. 5 days have passed since your last contact with the person with COVID-19 infection
2. You must wear a well-fitting mask for an additional 5 days around others indoors.
and
3. You do ***not*** have symptoms.

PUBLIC HEALTH RECOMMENDATIONS

- Get tested, if possible, at least 5 days after last contact with the person with COVID-19, even if you do not have symptoms.

- Monitor your health.
 - If you develop symptoms, immediately self-isolate and get tested.
 - Contact your healthcare provider, if necessary.
