**CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH NEEDS PROGRAM  
FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

There are no income criteria for Children with Special Health Needs Program (CSHNP) services, except for limited financial assistance with medical specialty services. Medical specialty services include CSHNP Neighbor Island Cardiac and Neurology Clinics. CSHNP services include periodic assessments, service planning/coordination, and follow up. Financial eligibility criteria are met when family documents show income at or below, the levels for family size.
