Public Design – Award of Excellence *Hui Aloha Playground* County of Maui Department of Parks and Recreation

The Hui Aloha Playground is a successful example of a place that is accessible to people of all ages and abilities and why it was selected as this year's Award of Excellence recipient.



It took the hard work and collaboration of the County, the design and construction crews and many community volunteers to make this first “Boundless Playground” a reality. The mission of a “boundless playground” is to create barrier free and developmentally advantageous playgrounds for children of all abilities. The playground structures exceeded the accessibility requirements by having all entry points connect to an accessible route and by creating access to more than the minimum number of play elements. The judges all agreed that the accessible features were well integrated into the design of the play structures making the playground look and feel like a fun place for the entire family.
