## Public Design - Award of Merit

This multi-use bicycle and pedestrian path runs along the coastline of Kauai from Kapaa to Kealia. The route was divided into three sections based on the unique characteristics of each area. The Kapaa Town section provides access to and from several developments and reflects the more urbanized setting of Kapaa. This section also hosts a fishing bridge that provides access to all individuals. The second, Kealia Beach section can be described as the transition from the more urbanized area of Kapaa to the rural coastline of Kealia. Pavilions located along the route provide scenic views and shelter along this rugged shoreline. The Kealia Kai Subdivision Section is the final section and continues to reflect the rural feel of Kealia, from Kealia Landing to Kuna Beach.
