FACILITY ACCESS SPECIALIST/PLAN REVIEWER

The Disability and Communication Access Board (DCAB) has an opening for a full-time position in Honolulu for a Facility Access Specialist.

The Facility Access Specialist is part of the Facility Access Unit, and will primarily be responsible to review architectural plans and specifications of state and county projects to ensure conformance to the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) and the Fair Housing Accessibility Guidelines (FHAG) and Hawaii Outdoor Developed Areas Accessibility Guidelines (HODAAG). Additional responsibilities may include site surveys, review of design standards, and outreach to educate the public and design professionals on accessibility to buildings, facilities, and sites.

AA required, BA preferred. Ability to read architectural plans and specifications required. Background in design or construction and familiarity with accessibility guidelines desirable.

The position is a full-time, state position, exempt from civil service. Medical, dental, vacation leave, sick leave benefits are provided. The salary is commensurate with experience.
