FACILITY ACCESS SPECIALIST/PLAN REVIEWER

The Disability and Communication Access Board (DCAB) has an opening for a full-time or half-time position in Honolulu for a Facility Access Specialist II.

- The Facility Access Specialist II is part of the Facility Access Unit, and will primarily be responsible to review architectural plans and specifications of state and county projects to ensure conformance to the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) and the Fair Housing Accessibility Guidelines (FHAG) and Hawaii Outdoor Developed Areas Accessibility Guidelines (HODAAG).
- Additional responsibilities may include site surveys, review of design standards, provide technical assistance related to compliance with accessibility requirements, and outreach to educate the public and design professionals on accessibility to buildings, facilities, and sites.

Minimum qualifications: BA required. Ability to read architectural plans and specifications required. Background in design or construction and familiarity with accessibility guidelines desirable.

The position is a State position, exempt from civil service. The program will consider applicants seeking both full-time or part-time employment. No consultant contract will be considered.

Benefits: Medical, dental, vacation leave, sick leave benefits are provided.

Salary: The salary is commensurate with experience. Salary range based on full time employment is \$55,000 - \$60,000/year.
