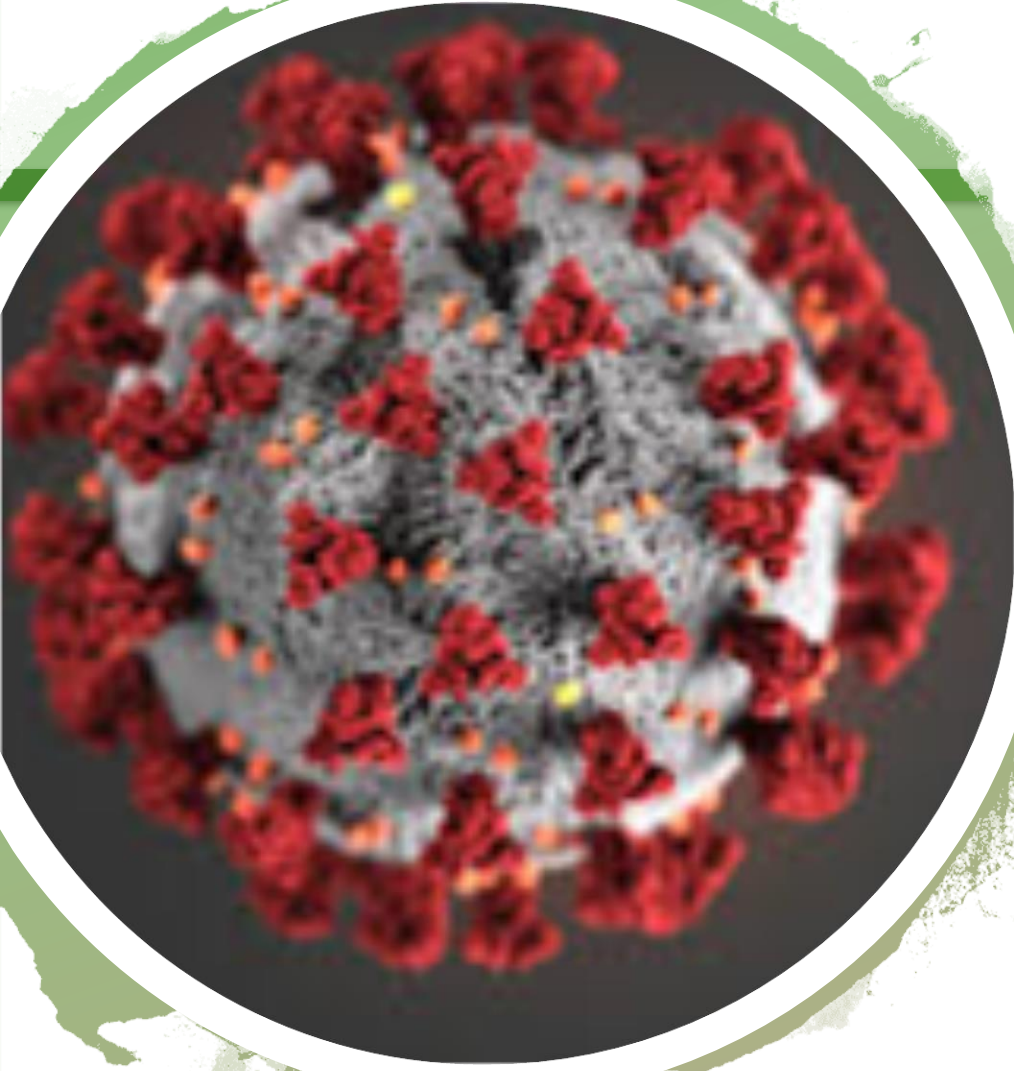

DDD



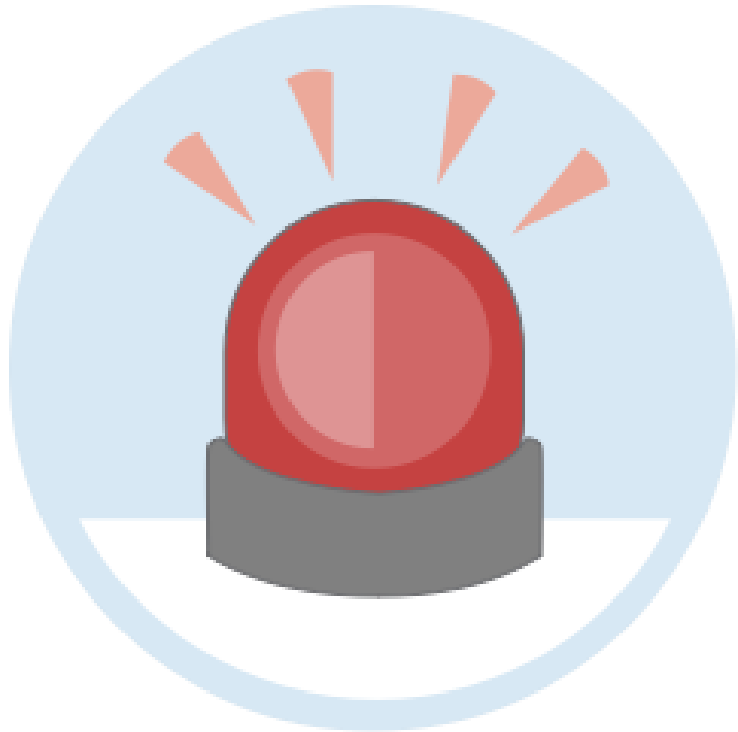
- DDD works with a Medicaid program to help serve and support Individuals with I/DD
- A short name for this program is called 1915 (c)
- DDD operates this program and makes sure services are available to support a person's Vision for a Good Life

COVID-19 Emergency



- Our President and Governor declared an emergency because of COVID-19

Emergency Request



- DDD asked federal government to help support Individuals and Advocates in this emergency
- This request is temporary and is called Appendix K

Staff Person



- May see staff person on the computer or phone
- May have staff person helping you at home instead of other places
- May receive services in your home

Staff Person

- May have a new staff person
- Process for family members to become staff person will be faster



Additional Hours

- Families may apply for additional Respite hours
- Licensed or Certified homes may apply for extra Additional Residential Supports



Private Duty Nursing

- Individuals who need more medical support may receive this support without other services
- If Individual is under 22 and needs medical support, health plan can help



Infection Supplies



- Available through health insurance or through Specialized Medical Equipment
