

<p>§11-148-16 <b>RECORD:</b> (b)(2)(C)(4) &amp; (6) During residence, foster adult record includes medications administered as ordered by physicians.</p>	<p>Effective immediately, the certified caregiver shall take the following action to minimize the risk of medication errors:</p> <p>(a) The certified caregiver shall review the physician's progress notes, after visit instructions or discharge summary/instructions at the conclusion of a medical examination or discharge. The certified caregiver shall never be afraid to ask questions, as it could save both the individual and the individual's caregivers from serious consequence.</p> <p>(b) When giving medications, the individual's Medication Administration Record (MAR) must be present.</p> <p>(c) Before giving a medication, the medication label and the physician's order shall be read and compared with the MAR (The physician's order, the MAR and the label must match).</p> <p>(d) Record the administration of the medication immediately on the individual's MAR.</p> <p>(e) The certified caregiver shall also follow best practice guidelines by adhering to the "six rights" of medication administration (RIGHT MEDICATION, RIGHT DOSE, RIGHT ROUTE/METHOD, RIGHT TIME, RIGHT PERSON, RIGHT DOCUMENTATION).</p> <p>(f) An Adverse Event Report (AER) documenting the medication error shall be completed and submitted to the foster adult's assigned Case Manager. A copy of the AER shall be submitted to the Certification Unit for verification by 10/24/20.</p> <p>(g) The certified caregiver shall be retrained on proper medication</p>

Effective immediately, the certified caregiver shall always keep a current and accurate accounting of the foster adult's money. The certified caregiver shall prepare an accounting of foster adult's money for August and September 2020 and forward a copy to the Certification Unit by 10/24/20 for verification.	
<b>§11-148-28 RESIDENT'S ACCOUNTS:</b> (d) Record contains a current inventory of possessions.	Effective immediately, the certified caregiver shall always have a current inventory of the foster adult's possessions. The certified caregiver shall prepare a current inventory of the foster adult's possessions and forward a copy to the Certification Unit by 10/24/20 for verification.
