



ELECTRONIC VISIT VERIFICATION

In December 2016, Congress passed the 21st Century Cures Act which requires states to use Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for personal care services by January 1, 2020.

Personal care services in the Medicaid I/DD Waiver includes Personal Assistance/Habilitation, Respite, Chore, and Private Duty Nursing. EVV captures the following data: participant name; type of service; date of service; start and end times of each visit; and verification of each visit by the participant or their designee.

Q: Regarding EVV-and Hard Edit Denial. As of right now, I have been having difficulty Punching in and Punching Out and seems in certain areas are just in "Roaming" so validating Punch In/Out times are not going through and I have been having to do it on my personal computer using the Portal. Come August 1, 2021, does it automatically just DENY Punch in / out times from the Portal rather than the EVV done by DCI on our phones? What would be the limits of error from the EVV?

If this is for Consumer Directed Services, contact Acumen with any problems regarding DCI. Acumen is using a third-party vendor for their EVV system. The statewide vendor for EVV is Sandata. Q: Once hard edits begin, will the denied claims show up on the normal remittance statement?

And not via email?

Yes, after the hard edits begin, the denied claims will show up on the 835 reports.

Q: What is the email to get our soft edit reports?

For EVV soft edit reports, those are sent from mainframe@azdoa.gov. If your agency has not been receiving these emails, email evv-mqd@dhs.hawaii.gov to let Med-QUEST know that you have not been receiving the emails.

Q: Is the hard edit final?

The EVV hard edits are scheduled to begin on 9/1/2021. This recently changed from 8/1/2021 to 9/1/2021. This date is subject to change.
