Extended Delay and Revised Provider Billing Instructions for Updated Codes and

SUBJECT:

The Department of Human Services (DHS), Med-QUEST Division (MQD), and Conduent have advised the Developmental Disabilities Division (DDD) that there is an extended delay in updates to certain service codes and modifiers in the Hawaii Prepaid Medical Management Information System (HPMMIS). As a result, some authorizations generated with the new service code and modifier combinations will not show in DHS Medicaid Online (DMO) until HPMMIS is updated. We anticipate the delay may take an additional 1-3 months for HPMMIS to be updated. Not all services are affected.

All Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) Services, with the exception of Private Duty Nursing (PDN), and all non-EVV services with up to 1 modifier have been updated in HPMMIS. Providers should see the authorizations with new code and modifier(s) in DMO.

PDN and most non-EVV services with more than 1 modifier are still pending update in HPMMIS. These service authorizations will not be in DMO. To mitigate a further delay in billing, DDD is in the process of converting the authorizations to the old codes and modifiers. This will allow providers to submit claims for services, when the authorization with the old code and modifier is in DMO. Once HPMMIS is updated, the authorizations will be converted back to the new codes and modifiers. DDD will notify providers when HPMMIS is updated for providers to begin using the new codes and modifiers to submit claims.

Non-EVV services that have a repurposed code with multiple modifiers are also still pending update in HPMMIS. However, DDD is not able to convert the authorizations to the old codes and modifiers because the old codes and modifiers have been repurposed for a different

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service. Providers will not be able to submit claims for these services until HPMMIS is updated. See affected services in table below.

Due to the extended delay in HPMMIS, DDD has revised the provider billing instructions for the updated codes and modifiers for providers to use in the interim. The billing instructions include revised instruction and examples for the following:

- Repurposed codes and modifiers;
- Phase-in of codes and modifiers without mid-year plan changes; and
- Mid-year plan changes.

Changes in the billing instructions have been identified by either a strikethrough or yellow highlight for additions, just like how revisions to the Standards are made.

Again, as the billing instructions were being revised, we realized that this process is very complicated and will be difficult for providers to understand based on the written instructions only. A training is scheduled for August 1, 2025, at 10:30 am-12:00 pm to go over the revisions to the billing instructions and to allow providers to ask questions. We apologize for the late scheduling but do think this will be beneficial for providers. If you are able to, please register for the training using the link below.
