A previously unvaccinated child under age 9 years needs a second dose of influenza vaccine. The earliest date this child may receive her second dose of influenza vaccine is 10/20/15 at which time she will be 3 years old. A 3 year old child may receive either a 0.5 ml dose of IIV or a 0.2 ml dose of LAIV.

Answer: 4) b or d
