Vaccines for Children (VFC) Eligibility Criteria

Source:

An underinsured child has health insurance, but the coverage does not include vaccines, or insurance covers only selected vaccines (VFC-eligible for non-covered vaccines only). Underinsured children are eligible to receive VFC vaccine only through a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), Rural Health Clinic (RHC), or under an approved deputization agreement. Please note that the Hawaii VFC program does not currently issue/recognize VFC provider deputization agreements.
