RotaTeq in a 2 month old	2.0 mL
Hepatitis A in a 19 year old	1.0 mL
Hepatitis B in a 19 year old	0.5 mL
MMR in a 19 year old	0.25 mL
Zostavax in a 70 year old	0.65 mL
