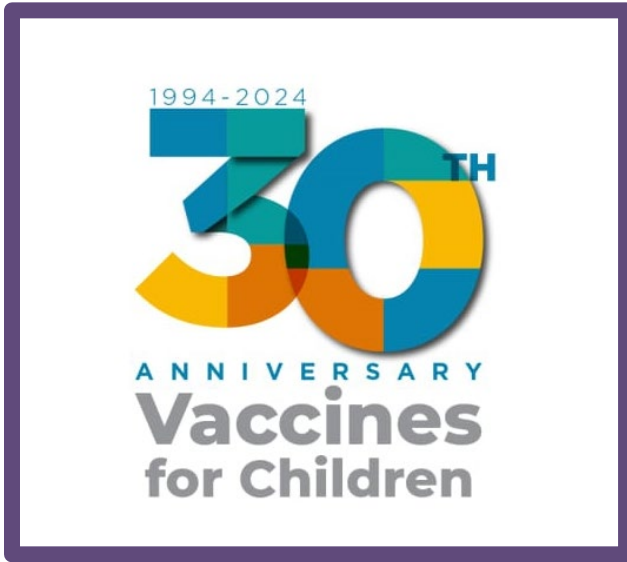

Vaccines for Children

Protecting America's children every day

The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program helps ensure that all children have a better chance of getting their recommended vaccines. VFC has helped prevent disease and save lives.



CDC estimates that vaccination of children born between 1994 and 2023 will:

prevent **508 million** illnesses
(31.9 million hospitalizations)



more than the current population of the entire U.S.A.

help avoid **1,129,000** deaths



greater than the population of Seattle, WA

save nearly **\$2.7 trillion** in total societal costs
(that includes \$540 billion in direct costs)



more than \$8,000 for each American

VFC Order Requirements:

1. Temperature logs of all storage units showing units are within range
 - 2-8 degrees Celsius for refrigerator
 - -50 to -15 degrees Celsius for freezer
2. Submit Inventory of Doses On Hand and Doses Administered Since Last Order
3. Submit Vaccine Administration Visit Record Forms or EMR Data Exchange

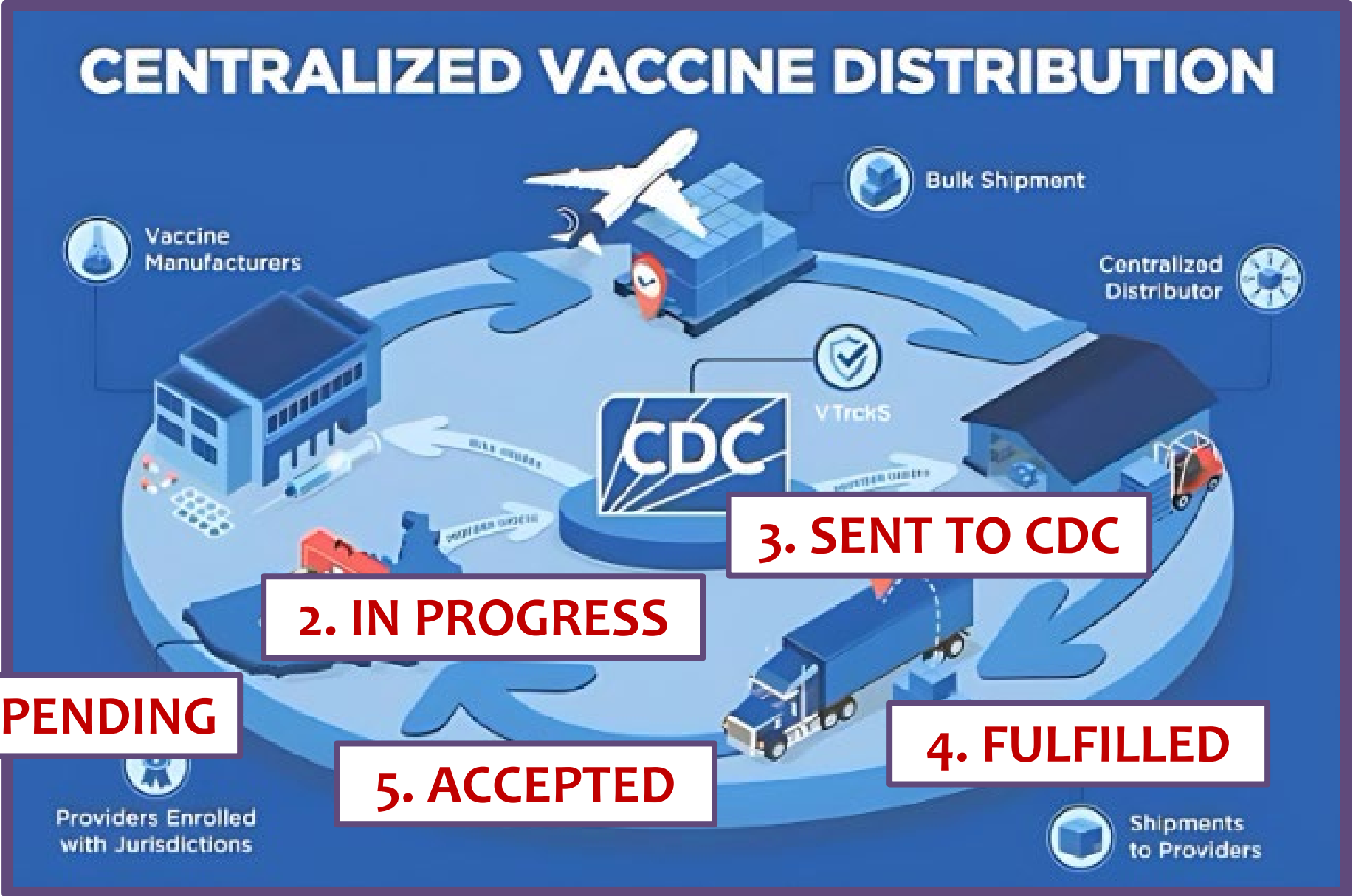

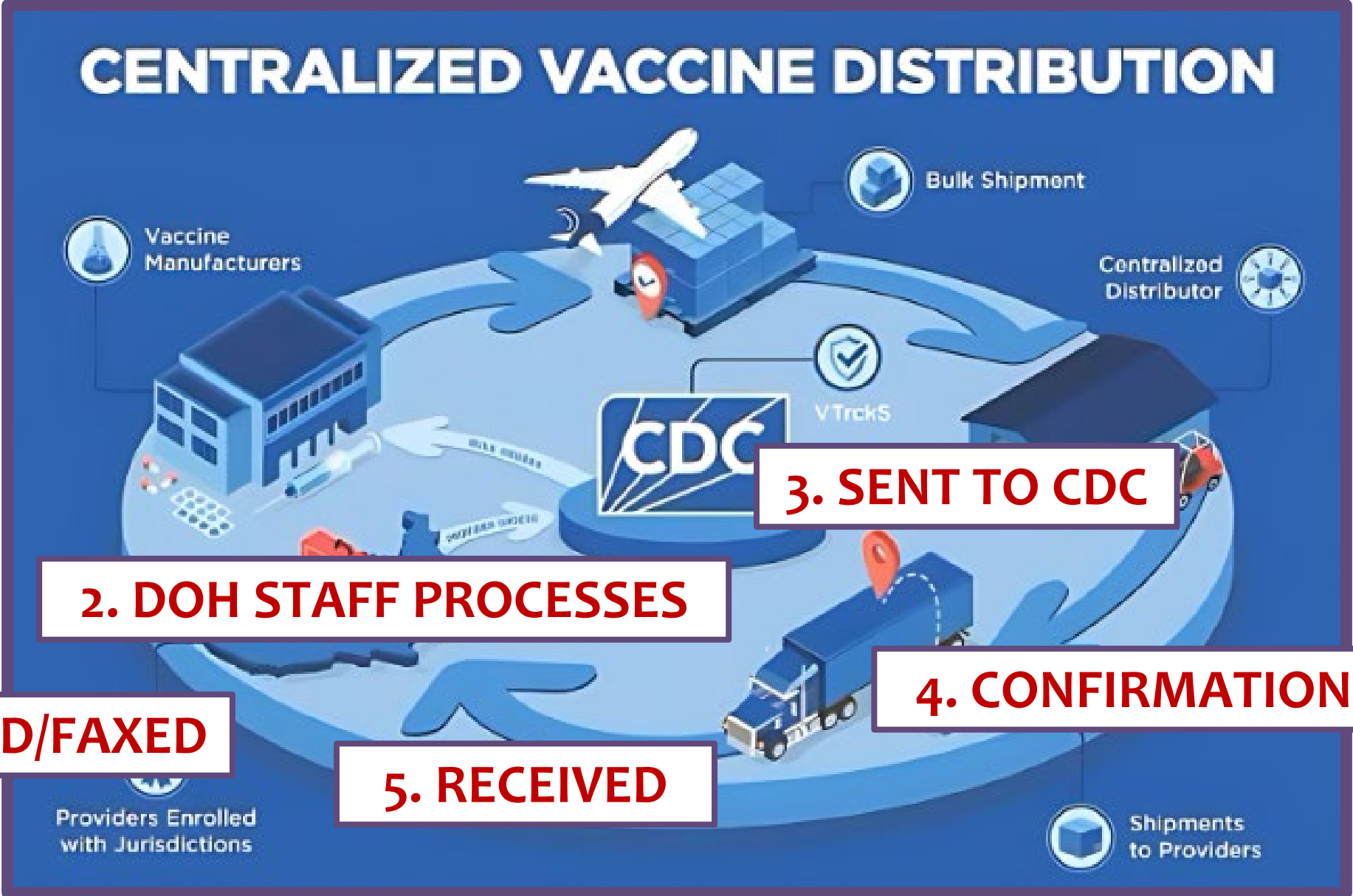

Types of Vaccine Shipments:

- McKesson
 - Includes warm/freeze temperature monitors with package
- Merck – Temperature stability based on shipment transit time
 - Varivax
 - 40 doses or less – 2-day transit time (unless packed for Monday delivery, will be 4-day transit time)
 - More than 40 doses – 4-day transit time
 - Proquad
 - 1-day transit time, may include temp monitoring device
- Pfizer – Temperature stability based on shipment transit time
 - Date listed on packing slip located on inside flap or page insert

- Providers must open vaccine packages immediately
- Locate temperature monitor(s) in the package and follow the instructions on the card
- Inspect the vaccine
- Compare the vaccine received with the vaccine products on the packing list
- Immediately store vaccine at appropriate temperatures
- Please don't reply to this email as this was sent from a mailbox that does not accept replies

Vaccine Shipment Tracking Information:

- Ensure staff is on-site to receive vaccines at estimated delivery day/time on the shipment tracking site
- Notify DOH VFC Staff at HawaiiVFC@doh.hawaii.gov if:
 - Shipment is delayed by the courier and is being “RETURNED TO SENDER”
 - If the primary coordinator does NOT receive a shipment tracking notification via email

- Monitoring shipment tracking information reduces vaccine loss due to missed deliveries
- Notifying DOH VFC staff of shipment issues EARLY speeds up the troubleshooting process
- Once DOH VFC staff are notified, shipment issues are sent to McKesson or the manufacturer and the CDC approves a replacement order

Receiving Vaccine Shipments:

1. Never refuse a vaccine shipment
2. Open immediately upon delivery
3. Check temperature monitoring device/strips (McKesson) or shipment transit time (Merck & Pfizer)
4. Inspect packaging and the number of doses received
5. Compare contents w/information on the packing slip
6. Store at appropriate temperatures

Receiving Vaccine Shipments:

- If there is damage to the shipment, a shortage of vaccine, or temperature excursions, notify DOH VFC staff at HawaiiVFC@doh.hawaii.gov:
 - Be sure to take a photo for documentation purposes
 - Avoid disposal of shipping boxes/packaging, packing slips, and temperature monitors until situation is resolved
 - Separate the suspected vaccine from non-affected vaccine stock, label “DO NOT USE”, and store at appropriate temperatures until vaccine viability is determined.

Receiving Vaccine Shipments:

- For temperature excursions (McKesson) and shipments arriving beyond the allowed transit time (Merck and Pfizer):
 - Contact the distributor on the same day of delivery

 - Merck – CDC/VFC Vaccine Inquiry Form

VFC Pfizer Shipment Packing List:

- Providers have reported that it is difficult to distinguish between Pfizer commercial (private stock) shipments and VFC shipments
- To distinguish between VFC and private stock shipments, look at the packing slip and/or label printed on the inside flap of the shipment.
