This position independently performs inspections and/or investigations of a variety of premises for evidence of mosquitoes, rodents, flies, fleas and other vectors of diseases and recommends corrective and abatement measures; explains and enforces vector control laws, rules and regulations and provides advice on the types of chemicals, equipment, tools and technology used in vector control; and performs other related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

To qualify, you must meet all of the following requirements:

EDUCATION: Graduation from high school or equivalent.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of progressively responsible work experience which involved inspecting premises for evidence of various pests and vectors; recommending and initiating necessary corrective activities or other work experience in the field of public health which has given the applicant knowledge of general sanitation and vector-control measures.

LICENSE: A valid driver's license is required. For those positions requiring a driver's license, you **must possess** a valid driver's license at the time of appointment. The immediate vacancies have this requirement.

Who May Apply

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION TO WORK REQUIREMENT: The State of Hawaii requires that all persons seeking employment with the government of the State shall be citizens, nationals, or permanent resident aliens of the United States, or eligible under federal law for unrestricted employment in the United States.
