**Vector Control Worker I
\$3,270 monthly**

This position receives formal training in the life cycle and habits of vectors, vector control methods, pesticide application and calibration procedures. Works as a member of a crew to receive on-the-job training in conducting vector control surveillance and abatement activities.

Minimum Qualifications

To qualify, you must meet all of the following requirements:

KNOWLEDGE OF: Common hand tools such as picks, shovels, hoes and power equipment such as power sprayers; methods and techniques of pesticides application; tools and equipment used in vector control and their proper maintenance; and safety practices relating to the vector control program.

ABILITY TO: Read, understand and carry out oral and written instructions; perform simple arithmetic computations including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; conduct vector control surveillance and abatement activities in accordance with standard methods and procedures; utilize personal protective equipment; learn calibration principles and procedures; fill out appropriate report forms; perform manual work tasks; operate a light truck; and lift and carry, with the assistance of one other person, containers of mosquito fish weighing up to one hundred twenty (120) pounds.

EXPERIENCE: Work experience which demonstrated the ability to read and follow oral and written instructions and perform simple arithmetic computations including multiplication and division.

LICENSE: A valid driver's license is required for some positions. For those positions requiring a driver's license, you **must possess** a valid driver's license at the time of appointment. The immediate vacancies have requirement.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Applicants must possess the Department of Transportation (DOT), Airports Division, Airport Motor Vehicle Operator's permit within the six (6) months probationary period.

Who May Apply

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION TO WORK REQUIREMENT: The State of Hawaii requires that all persons seeking employment with the government of the State shall be citizens, nationals, or permanent resident aliens of the United States, or eligible under federal law for unrestricted employment in the United States.
