The primary purpose of this position is to supervise the Building, General Shop and Automotive Maintenance unit in performing the construction, maintenance, alteration and repair of structures, buildings, roadways and parking areas, automobiles, heavy equipment, combustion engines, generators, light equipment, adjacent grounds and other related areas; and performs other related duties as assigned for Kalaupapa Settlement.

Minimum Qualification Requirements

To qualify, you must meet all of the following requirements:

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: Eight (8) years of work experience in performing a variety of work in the construction and maintenance of buildings, structures or electrical or plumbing systems of which Four (4) years shall have been as a fully competent skilled worker AND including one (1) year of supervisory experience which included planning and scheduling the work of other fully competent workers, assigning and reviewing their work, providing training and evaluating their work performance; OR any equivalent combination of training and experience.

DRIVER'S LICENSE: Applicants must possess a valid driver's license at the time of appointment.

Who May Apply

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION TO WORK REQUIREMENT: The State of Hawaii requires that all persons seeking employment with the government of the State shall be citizens, nationals, or permanent resident aliens of the United States, or eligible under federal law for unrestricted employment in the United States.
