

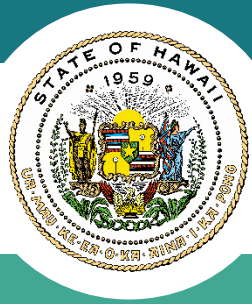

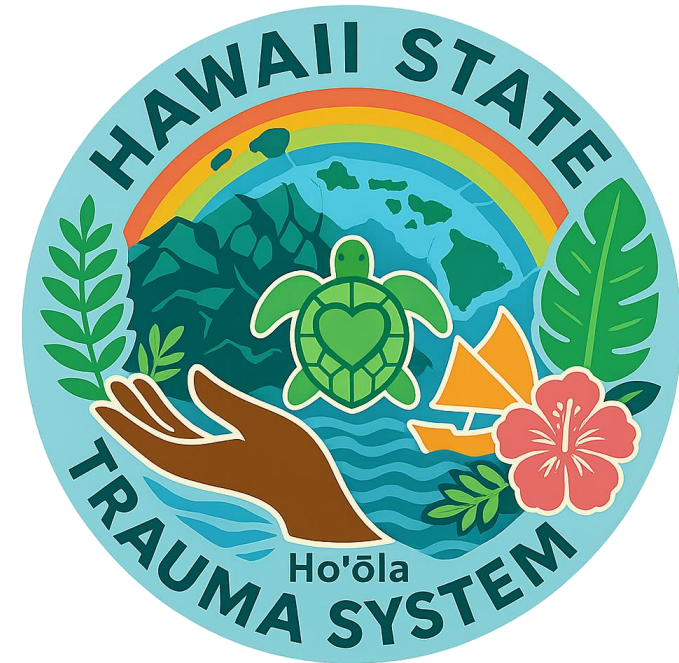

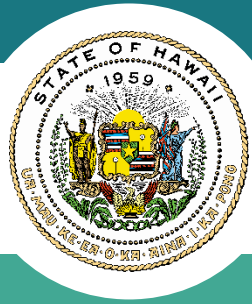


## What is TraumaNet (T-Net)?

- TraumaNet (T-Net) is a public-grade radio system that incorporates radio, broadband/LTE, and WiFi. T-Net will connect all the Trauma Centers onto one communication system

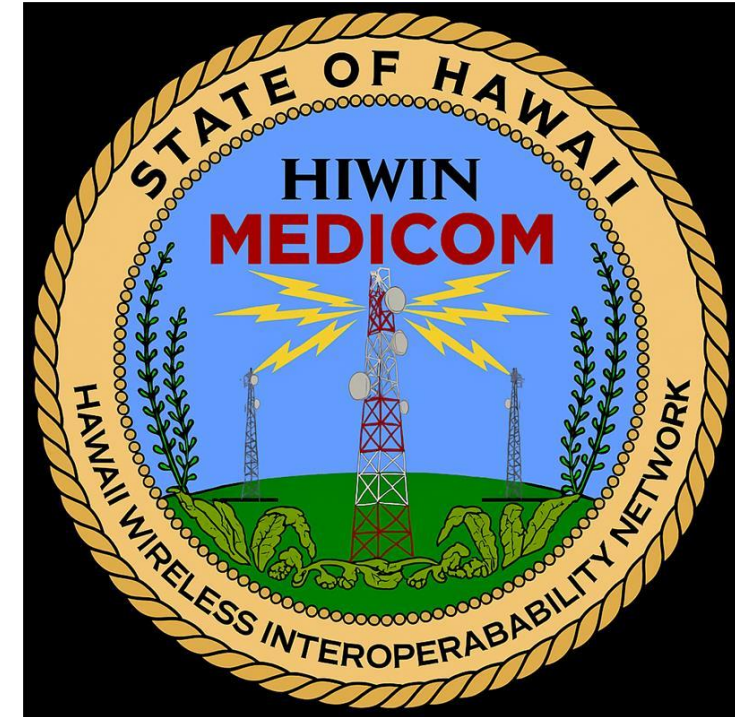

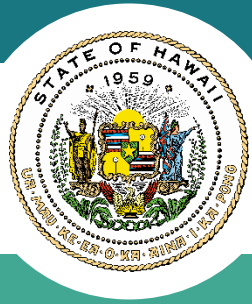


## T-Net Purpose

- Purpose is to help support logistics during MCIs where Trauma Centers and other resources need to collaborate
- T-Net is part of Medicom
  - Medicom is part of the overall HIWIN infrastructure
- T-Net will be integrated into the overall air medical system
  - Air medical assets could have their own talk group and access to county hospitals once established by the Branch

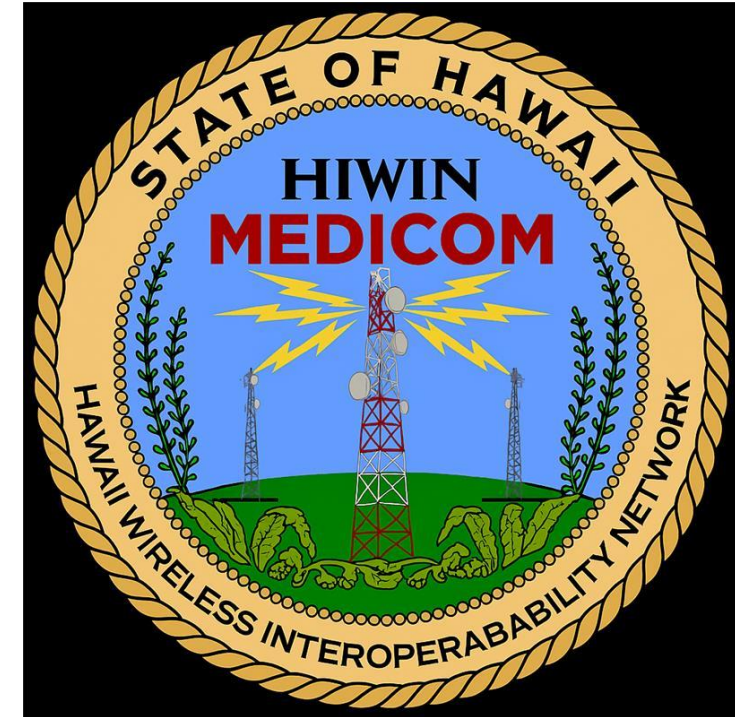

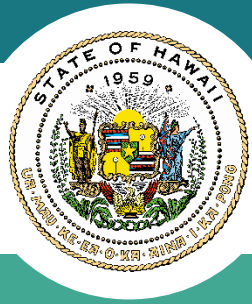


## T-Net Planning Phase

- Radios will go to all Level 3 (and above) trauma centers
- Each Trauma Center initially gets 2 radios
  - One radio for the Trauma Program Manager (TPM), one radio for Trauma Medical Director (TMD)

## What Does T-Net Need From Trauma Centers?

- Site evaluation of each Trauma Center
- HIWIN radio reception testing
- Access to WiFi without splash screen
- Push-to-talk alternative devices such as radios, phones, iPads, computers, etc.
