

Manufacturer Ranking by Pounds Recycled in 2015

Starting in 2008, manufacturers of covered electronic devices (CEDs) and covered televisions (CTVs) sold in the state of Hawaii were subject to the Hawaii Electronic Waste and Television Recycling and Recovery Law. CEDs are defined as: computers, computer monitors, printers, and portable computers. By January 1, 2010, CED manufacturers were required to have their recycling programs established for Hawaii and by January 1, 2011, CTV manufacturers were required to have their recycling programs established.

By law, the Hawaii Department of Health is required to rank CED manufacturers by the number of pounds they recycled. Table 1 displays the rankings for the manufacturers who reported recycling CEDs in Hawaii. There were 39 CED manufacturers who reported recycling zero (0) pounds of CEDs in Hawaii, these manufacturers are listed alphabetically in Table 2.
