

Hawaii Electronic Device Recycling and Recovery Law Collector Registration Form

Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 339D provides, in part:

- Collector definition: "Collector" means a person that accepts electronic devices for reuse or delivers the devices to a recycler for the purposes of this chapter.
- Collectors shall register with the Department of Health (DOH) and pay to the department a registration fee of \$250.00 by January 1, 2023 and annually thereafter.
- Collectors shall maintain records for a minimum of five years of the following: the amount, in weight, of electronic devices it has collected for recycling and reuse and the amounts sent for recycling and reuse and bills of lading or weight tickets for all electronic devices sent for recycling or reuse.
- Collectors shall report to the DOH by March 31, 2024 and annually thereafter, the weight of all electronic devices collected for recycling or reuse in the previous year. Reports shall be submitted on forms prescribed by the DOH and shall indicate the weight of electronic devices sent to each recycler and the number of electronic devices that were reused.
- Collectors shall possess and maintain all necessary business and environmental permits.
