# Hawaii Electronic Device Recycling and Recovery Law

### **Retailer Information**

Retailers of electronic devices (EDs) sold in the State of Hawaii shall only sell or offer to sell EDs registered with the Department of Health (DOH) and must provide their customers with information on recycling programs offered by manufacturers.

#### **Retailer Definition**

Retailer means any person who offers electronic devices for sale, other than for resale by the purchaser, through any means, including sales outlets, catalogs, or the Internet.

## **Electronic Devices Described**

Electronic devices include computers, computer printers, computer monitors, portable computers with a screen size greater than four inches measured diagonally, and televisions with a viewable screen of nine inches or larger.

### **Retailer Responsibility**

- Retailers shall only sell or offer to sell electronic devices that have a visible, permanent label clearly identifying the manufacturer of that device and the manufacturer has registered with the State of Hawaii.
- Retailers are required to make information available to their customers on collection services for discarded electronic devices in the State of Hawaii.
- Retailers shall make the DOH website and phone number available to their customers.
