## **Primary Health Care Provider in Medical Home**

Direct and coordinate early hearing detection and intervention process for the baby, including screening, audiological and medical evaluation, early intervention and hearing aids.

## Screening is done by 1 month of age by:

• **Hospitals & Other Screening Providers –** Where they provide information for families, screen, rescreen, submit EHDI data, and link child to a medical home.

## After screening is done, a Diagnostic Evaluation is done by 3 months of age by:

- Audiologists and medical specialists Where they evaluate, diagnose, fit hearing aids, submit EHDI data, link child to medical home, and link them to early intervention.
- **Department of Health Newborn Hearing Screening Program -** Where they facilitate referrals, link child to medical home, link to early intervention, and mange statewide data.

After evaluation is completed, child is enrolled into early intervention by 6 months of age by:

• **Early intervention Programs** – Where they focus on care coordination, ongoing services, family support, submit EHDI data, and link to medical home.
