Explanation of Limited Services

Linkage to Care and treatment for already diagnosed individuals

- Linkage to Care refers to anyone with a positive HIV diagnosis seeking HIV medical services.
- Treatment can be offered to those who have already tested positive for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, or Syphilis

Treatment for those with STI symptoms – No STI testing

- This is anyone who has not been diagnosed but is experiencing symptoms that may indicate infection with Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, or Syphilis
- Symptoms include dysuria; vaginal, urethral discharge; ulcers to the mouth, genitals, or rectum; rectal discharge; pain on defecation; or urge to defecate frequently
- There will be no testing for Chlamydia or Gonorrhea, during this time. Only treatment for these STIs will be provided

Select services for contacts of confirmed STI and HIV cases – No STI testing

- Anyone who has been informed of a potential exposure to Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, or Syphilis, will be offered treatment
- Anyone who has been informed of a potential exposure to HIV, will be offered a rapid HIV test
- There will be no testing for Chlamydia or Gonorrhea, during this time. Only treatment for these STIs will be provided

HIV rapid testing and syphilis testing for high risk individuals only

• A high risk individual is anyone mentioned above, or anyone who has engaged in risky behavior with another high risk person. This includes men who have sex with men, sex with a transgender, sex with an

injecting drug user, and sharing needles or injecting drugs.
