<sup>3</sup> Concomitant ART is required for HDAP coverage of entecavir.

<sup>4</sup> HDAP does not cover finasteride for treatment of male hair loss.

<sup>5</sup> SAMHSA waiver and DEA registration are required to prescribe buprenorphine.

<sup>6</sup> HDAP covers influenza vaccine for uninsured patients only

<sup>7</sup> HDAP coverage of somatropin is limited to treatment of wasting or cachexia to increase lean body mass and body weight and improve physical endurance. Concomitant ART is required. No coverage for any off-label use
