The Hawai'i Gender ECHO Program (G-ECHO) was created to expand access to gender-affirming care for keiki in Hawai'i. In collaboration with medical and behavioral health clinicians, providers, members of the community, and The Hawai'i Department of Health, Sexual and Gender Minority Workgroup, we have curated a network of affirming providers and identified referral pathways to make care more accessible. This directory is intended for gender diverse youth and families in Hawai'i. Services included fall into the following categories: behavioral health, community groups, housing, and basic needs, medical, community resource, and social services.
