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Why we use them? Who are they for?

WHY WE USE THEM???

- Contamination widespread and varied.
- Owners, public, workers unaware.
- Cleanup over an extended time.
- Residual risk reduced by precautions.

WHO ARE THEY FOR???

- Property owners
- Prospective purchasers
- Contractors
- General public

THREE TYPES OF EHMPS

• Areawide

• Site-specific

Pre-construction

AREAWIDE EHMP

- Assumes widespread contamination.
- Assumes contamination will be encountered.
- Addresses areas yet to investigated
- Addresses common areas (streets, parks, etc.)

SITE-SPECIFIC EHMP

- Req'd when unrestricted use not attainable.
- Specifies additional control measures.
- Requires ongoing compliance.

PRE-CONSTRUCTION EHMP

- An investigation may not have occurred.
- Specifies pre-construction precautions.
- Aimed at construction worker safety.
- Most important for intrusive activities.

WAIKOLOA AEHMP SPECIFICS

- Provides history and investigations.
- Discusses land use, geology, and hydrology.
- Outlines responsibilities for key parties.

WAIKOLOA AEHMP SPECIFICS (CON'T)

- Describes risk management of UXO.
- Describes measures HDOH will take.
- Prescribes risk management actions.



- AEHMP serves as public advisory.
- AEHMP a placeholder...not a remedy.
- Effectiveness relies on cooperation.
