

## **TSUNAMI EVACUATION PLANS**

One out of five Kaua'i households are not familiar with the tsunami evacuation zones island-wide.



ALL households in a tsunami hazard zone should immediately evacuate to higher ground when a tsunami warning is issued!



## HURRICANE EVACUATION PLANS

As the category of storm increases, more Kauaʻi families plan to evacuate to a public shelter.
