How to Apply for WIC





FOR MAUI RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY WILDFIRES

The <u>Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)</u> waives the requirement for documents for those who are impacted by disasters. Physical presence can also be waived so that enrollments can be performed over the phone if an in-person appointment is not possible.

You may qualify if you are pregnant, breastfeeding, postpartum or have children under 5 years old.

Hawai'i WIC does not require proof of immigration status to determine eligibility.

To apply for WIC:
